





PROPERTY COMMITTEE NEWSLETTER - JULY 2018

CEILING AND LIGHTING REPAIRS

In the last few Property Committee Newsletters and Updates to Council, we've indicated the need to obtain bids to fulfill our electrical and drywall needs. We finally have two bids for drywall and one for electrical. If anyone wishes, we can provide a physical walk through so you can see the repairs we are proposing. For electrical, we plan to update the lights on either side of the Sanctuary. We need to add lighting in the hallway between the Fellowship Hall and the Sanctuary and update the lighting in the Narthex. This work would need to be done before we can remove and replace some of the damaged drywall in the ceilings. We are starting to get a moldy summer smell in the entry way and believe this is coming from damaged insulation/drywall in that area. Both drywall quotes have included removing damaged drywall throughout these areas (estimated at 8 full sheets). There is always the possibility that once the ceiling is open, additional needs (and funding) will come to light – but we've tried hard to anticipate all the work that needs to be done. That total of the drywall and electrical will run between \$22,324 and \$24,303, depending on whether the low bidder will hold their pricing and if they can get us on their schedule this year.

Funding: At the beginning of 2018, the Capital Campaign Account was \$15,455. The cement project (that was completed the week of June 10) was \$4,000 leaving a Capital Campaign balance of \$11,455. As you can see, we will need between \$11,000 and \$13,000 in additional funds. The Property Committee will be taking this to Council on July 10 asking them to help identify sources of funding. If we are to complete this project in 2018, we need to move forward very soon. We realize it's early summer but by the time funds are identified and contractors schedule our project, it could be fall/winter.

SHRED YOUR CONFIDENTIAL PAPERS DAY

We obtained bids to have a confidential document shredding vehicle come to Christiania. We are not sure if there is a need in our church but thought our elderly and some shut-ins could use this service to prevent potential identify theft. There is a Heritage gathering in July where we can see if there is a need. The cost for this is approximately \$500. The service would be free to Christiania members and our local community. More about this later.

PAINTING OF THE OUTDOOR WINDOW FRAMES

Halleluiah!!! That fabulous Sharon Buckley has undertaken the huge project of getting this outside painting done between the weeks she is volunteering at Camp Onomia. If you have some spare time, please see Sharon to volunteer a few hours. Thank you Sharon.

NUMBERS OF EXTERIOR DOORS

We met with Cheryl Mohn of the Décor Advisory Committee. We agreed on the size and location of the numbers. You will soon see numbers on each of our 7 exterior doors. These are all requirements of our Lockdown Procedures.

CEMENT WORK

Our local contractor completed this project the week of June 11. It is very exciting to see our project list being completed one project at a time.

EAGLE SCOUT PROJECT

We have another young adult in our congregation who is working on his Eagle Scout Badge. We have suggested several projects. More on this in the next Newsletter.
