

News from your Property Commission

SPACE NEEDS MEETING: On November 20, the Property Committee facilitated a meeting on space needs in our church. There were thoughts that the area now designated as the Youth Room could be better used as a Multi-Purpose Room and the youth could occupy several rooms in the Education Wing. After much discussion between the meeting participants and the Executive Council, the decision was made to leave the youth in the large room. However, the Youth Room will be cleaned up, several large pieces of furniture will be removed, the walls will be painted and window dressings will either be repaired or replaced. This will allow other functions and activities in the room when needed. Jason Estrem has volunteered to paint the room in early January. Thank you Jason.

2017 PROJECTS: The past month has been quiet so we would like to take the opportunity to let you know what we will be working on in 2017 – with Executive Council's blessings, of course.

The new carpet will be installed in mid-January. We will finally be rid of the ugly cement floors.

Lockdown Procedures - It needs to be done. We need to create a plan of action in case of an active shooter in our church or outside. We will be working on this in 2017. Better safe than sorry.

Masonry Needs – We need to tear out the sidewalk in front of the Education Wing; we need to install concrete pads in front of the two new sheds we recently installed; and we need to put a concrete pad in the back entrance where the patio was removed.

We need to determine whether the septic system at the Parsonage is in need of replacement or whether the repairs made last fall will take care of the problems.

We need to determine the best replacement method for our stained glass window frames.

We need to continue our painting of the windows on the north and east side of the church. The paint has been purchased, the manpower is needed.

We need to continue with landscaping on the east side of the church.

We need to continually monitor conditions in the Education Wing and Youth Room.

We need to brainstorm uses for the ballfield.

We need to brainstorm projects to enhance our back area where the patio was removed.

We need to determine what the best steps are in preserving our parking lot.

We need to investigate and remedy the water problem over the aisle between the Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall.


