What is the church? BY PASTOR JON RHODES

Christiania friends,

What a whirlwind 2025 has been so far. January was focused on many things, including Christiania's Annual Meeting—always on the last Sunday of January. By the time you read these words we will have entered our 2025 ministry season and completed our Annual Meeting. A regular Annual Meeting of the church gathers the people of the church to accomplish two things: celebrate our life together and plan for the future. We do both by sharing stories and visions, by making commitments to a new budget, and in our votes for new leaders.

It takes a lot of people to be the church. What is the church? Christiania's Constitution suggests, "The Church is a people created by God in Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit, called and sent to bear witness to God's creative, redeeming, and sanctifying activity in the world (C4.01.)." We are gathered to be sent to share God's story. I really like that last part, "...called and sent to bear witness to God's creative, redeeming, and sanctifying activity in the world." How are we doing? How are we sharing (witnessing) the most important things God is doing?

In the next part of Chapter 4 of Christiania's Constitution (C4.02), we hear more about how we are to participate in God's mission as Christ's Church. The first of six points reads: "(a) Worship God in proclamation of the Word and administration of the sacraments and through lives of prayer, praise, thanksgiving, witness, and service." Many people think of constitutions as boring, dry, and hard to read—I find ours to be helpful and interesting. Christiania's Constitution suggests our worship is how we live—deeply trusting in God and God's practices of loving and praising God, loving others, and serving.

The Word of God provides a similar perspective when the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Romans suggests that worship is life: Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. (Romans 12:1 NIV) Two questions arise for me: (1) How are we doing together as church in worship, proclamation, sharing the sacraments and living lives of "... prayer, praise, thanksgiving, witness, and service."? And (2) How are we doing individually along the same lines—living lives of worship?

Consider those places where your life is aligned with this Godly vision as well as places for growth.

I'd like to offer a special word of thanks to so many of you who submitted Statements of Intent as part of our annual Stewardship campaign, especially those participating for the first time. People of Christiania, your generosity is amazing! Keep up the good work of being Christ's church. See you in worship. Mark your calendars: the Lenten season begins with Ash Wednesday on March 5.
