Message from Interim Pastor Rebecca

"The world is changed," said Galadriel in The Fellowship of the Rings, concerned for the passing of the ages.

"The world is changed and it's not your fault," said the Rev. Dr. David Lose at the 2014 Synod Assembly concerned for those feeling left behind by Social Media Restructuring.

"We will all be changed" said the Apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 15:52, concerned to let the faithful know that no one will be left behind.

The world is changing, it always has and God is always ahead caring for us, but sometimes churches fall behind in how we reach out to neighbors and one another.

Interim times are good, says this interim pastor, because it's a time when congregations can choose to consider what traditions and practices have worked in the past and what may need to be changed to more fully include all of God's children in the future.

As your interim pastor, I have been delighted to experience the wealth of young people associated with Christiania but have seen too, how often they get caught up in the urgencies and emergencies of our ever changing, technological world. As one who deeply respects the gathered people of Christiania, I am concerned about how to best reach out to our younger members yet also honor the rich experiences of those not guite so young.

With the help of the Membership and Congregational Life Ministry Teams, on Sunday, March 18 and an earlier Sunday in January, a number of young families gathered and talked about what would be most helpful for them to more fully join in the community and worship at Christiania. There were many suggestions. While some ideas can, others cannot be instituted yet and some are already under discussion. Among the many topics, not all of which are included here, were having: more information about what's happening at church on media younger people use; the children's play bags refreshed; more for children to do in church services; children leave for Sunday School after the Children's sermon; snacks during the Sunday School opening; a consistent, reliable Nursery attendant; a place at the tables in Fellowship hall; Sunday afternoon activities for families and many other ideas.

As we go forward trusting our God who took on human form and lived among us, there is no limit to the possibilities but to realize these will take great generosity and the willing help of many. Having come to know you, I trust we can go forward with Christ in our conversations and actions.

In the meantime, I will be on vacation from April 16-May 16. Christiania's great Call Committee will continue the call process for Christiania's Senior Pastor. During my time away, a colleague and excellent ELCA pastor, Kisten Thompson, will serve Christiania part-time. Pr. Kisten will be here on Sundays for worship and Wednesdays for the Confirmation program and in between as needed and for emergencies, visits and the smooth running of the congregation. Pr. Kisten has been a nurse and is one of the wiser and most compassionate of people. I know that you will welcome her and hope you will call on her as needed. I am as anxious for her to meet you as for you to meet her. There are many wonderful pastors and many wonderful congregations. Kisten is such a pastor and you are such a congregation. God bless you one and all, I look forward to catching up with you in May.

CALL COMMITTEE UPDATE

The call committee is moving right along. During the month of March, the congregation had the opportunity to nominate ELCA pastors that would fit the needs of Christiania. Members of the congregation submitted eight names for consideration. These names were submitted to the synod. The call committee will not be involved in determining whether or not a nominated pastor will be brought forward for an interview. That is up to the synod, but we have been assured that all names submitted will be given serious consideration. Thanks for your input.

The synod is now looking over all the potential candidates. They will be considering those nominated by the congregation, those applying based on our posting on the synod web site and those pastors they are aware of that match the needs of our congregation. When they have completed that process they will bring forth the names of 3-5 candidates that will be interviewed by our call committee. We are anxiously/patiently awaiting those names.

While the synod is busy with that process, the call committee is busy preparing for those interviews. We have individually come up with a number of interview questions. After a lively discussion, we have narrowed the guestions to a reasonable number. On March 26, Pastor Lees from the synod will join us again to further train us on the interview process.

We are looking forward to beginning interviews in April. We will continue to provide weekly updates in the Sunday bulletin and on the website. We are also providing a short verbal update during the Sunday announcements.

Continue to pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us and grant us the ability and wisdom to bring to Christiania a faithful pastor who will care for us and equip us to do the Lord's work.
