Message from Interim Pastor Rebecca

Newsletter: March 2018

Prayer: Truth, Trust and Showing Up

One of my favorite biblical stories occurs mid-way through the book of Acts. 12:1-17, and involves a startling response to prayer. King Herod, having discovered that local political leaders enjoyed his imprisoning and killing the leaders of the new Christian church, dispatched James and captured Peter. Following Jesus' and Jewish teachings, the church gathered to pray fervently to God to spare Peter.

Then, in the jail nearby, an angel of God appeared, lighting up Peter's cell but he didn't awake, nor did the guards to whom he was chained. So the angel jostled Peter urging him to get up. Dazedly he did, his chains fell off, the guards didn't wake and the prison doors just opened. When Peter reached the street and realized what was happening, the angel disappeared. Because he was now a hunted man, Peter rushed to the house where the church gathered and knocked on the locked door. Rhoda responded. When she heard his voice she was so excited, she ran to tell the others, leaving Peter outside. The church was so busy praying that when they heard her they assumed she was out of her mind or had seen a ghost. Don't disturb us Rhoda, we're busy praying for Peter's release.

How she finally convinced them is not clear but when some went to the gate, they opened it, let Peter in and, I trust, thanked God for answering their prayers.

Pray, because prayer is God's command throughout the biblical texts. Prayer reveals truth (John 8:31), and reasons to trust and show up.

Life today isn't easy, it was less easy for Peter. We read of his faithful actions and marvel, but we who are baptized have the same gift Peter did, the gift of the Holy Spirit, but few are called to struggle as Peter. Each, however, is called to pray as Jesus, the church and Peter did.

The first three Gospels are full of Jesus' instructions to pray and his examples. For what should we pray, for that which concerns us and for each other. This Lenten season we will together explore a particular prayer. In this time of transition at Christiania, the leaders of the Congregation have asked us to pray for God to touch the heart of a gifted pastor to come walk with this congregation towards Christiania's future mission. Pray for our Call Committee. It is also good to ask that God bring us a faithful Children. Youth and Family Director to work with our new pastor, our CYF leader and the CYF ministry team to better support the young people of this congregation.

Do not lose heart. In times of transition it is common for some to turn back to traditions that once served but which don't work so well today in our Social Media world. It is also common to become discouraged, to step back and wait to see what will happen. The body of Christ who is Christiania has resisted much of this and prayer will lead us forward. As we continue our concern for God and one another, it matters to show up at worship and gatherings and participate in ministry teams and commissions that lead and connect us.

When we reach out beyond what we know towards the will and work of God, the Holy Spirit blesses us with gifts of which we were unaware and the joy of community and hope we did not know we were missing. God bless and thank you all who have been so vitally and wonderfully involved.




EASTER FLOWERS

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

What an exciting start to 2018!

February marked the first meeting of the new Executive Council and we are excited to welcome Maren Zaffke and Derrick Hongerholt. I feel we are fortunate that Bruce Mohn is continuing to serve in the role of Vice President. The continuity that provides to the council in a year of change will provide stability and insights to keep things running smoothly. Greg Silus graciously agreed to continue as a member at large to guide the transition of the secretary role to Maren. Kim continues her dedication to the council and CYF. Lori Clausen continues as an at large member and is the council appointed representative to the Call Committee. Brian McGregor rounds out our council in his second year as an at large

member. I thank you all for your partnership and guidance. Please reach out to any council members with questions or recommendations, we are all here to serve you and Christiania.

Our congregational meetings in January were well attended and important steps to kicking off 2018. I enjoyed attending my first Town Hall hosted by the Mission Exploratory Team (MET), it was very informative. Bruce gave a great overview of the event in the February Newsletter. The annual meeting was well attended and our 2018 annual budget was approved. While the 2018 budget is higher than 2017, it will allow us to move forward with hiring our new Pastor and a full time CYF director.

The Call Committee met for the first time on Thursday, February 15. Joe Lees attended the meeting and provided guidance to our committee on the process they will follow. The Call Committee has a unique challenge – keeping the congregation informed on the progress of the search with updates on the process while maintaining absolute confidentiality on all details surrounding candidates. Two requests:

Remember to include our call committee and future pastor in your prayers. Refrain from asking Call Committee members about candidates – quantity, names, etc. – this information must remain confidential and we don't want to create an uncomfortable environment.

Our Leadership Orientation was Saturday, February 17. This session is for all teams and committees to come together at the beginning of the year and align on expectations and roles. We covered the roles of the different teams and the new Ministry Board organization. Attendees seemed to appreciate the information and enjoyed breakfast.
